Captain Silas

"Depth gauge sitting at eight thousand meters. Report hydrophone status, Mercy."

Operator Mercy

"Acoustics clean, Captain... Wait. Primary hydrophone array just caught a pulse."

[SFX: SUB_BASS_PULSE]

Technician Ethan

"Hydro-frequency reading forty hertz! It is not seismic, Silas. It is rhythmic! Below oceanic bedrock!"

Captain Silas

"Bedrock is solid granite down here. Nothing operates under eight kilometers of ocean! Reroute sensor array!"

The Phantom Transmission

"... Signal Zero Nine... Bedrock breach in progress..."

Operator Mercy

"Captain! The transmission isn't coming through seawater! It is vibrating through our own bathyscaphe hull!"

MARIANA TRENCH HYDROPHONE MISSION TECHNICAL BRIEF

In 1974, deep-sea research bathyscaphes in the western Pacific recorded unexplained low-frequency signals originating from 8,000+ meters below sea level. Known colloquially as 'Signal 09', these mechanical pulses exhibited precise mathematical intervals inconsistent with biological or tectonic activity.
